This will be the final packet before our competition. I assure you I have made every reasonable effort to accommodate your requests. I encourage you to check our website at thhsmusic.com on the evening of Friday, April 18th for any last-minute instructions.

Please find “enclosed” in this packet a seating chart. *Please fill out one seating chart per composition and list your soloists and their instrument.* This will greatly help our judging panel recognize individuals for awards, etc.

Our featured “Lunch-time” performer this year is saxophonist Paul Navidad. Please read his attached bio. It promises to be an exciting performance!

ARRIVAL/PARKING

NOTE: The Trabuco Hills High School campus is currently experiencing the construction of a brand new parking complex and sports complex. **PARKING IS LIMITED.**

1) Please arrive 1 hour before your performance time.

2) DIRECTIONS:

From Interstate 5: Take El Toro Road and go east. Go right (south) on Santa Margarita Parkway. School and Santa Margarita Parkway parking lot entrance will be on the right at top of hill. *Only south-bound Santa Margarita Parkway has access to the parking lot.*

From the 241 (Toll Road): Take Portola / Santa Margarita Parkway exit. *(Do not take the Portola (Irvine) exit - the correct exit is further south.)* Head south on Portola/Santa Margarita Parkway. Once you pass El Toro Road, the school and Santa Margarita Parkway parking lot entrance will be on the right at top of hill. *Only south-bound Santa Margarita Parkway has access to the parking lot.*

Buses will enter the parking lot off of Santa Margarita Parkway, drop off students in front of the school, and exit onto Mustang Run. Guides will assist. Buses are to park on

Mustang Run (either the north or south side of Los Alisos). Please inform your bus driver about return pick-up times as the entrance and exit to the parking lot may experience congestion from the various events occurring on campus.

- 3) Spectators and parents may park in the main parking lot on the South side of campus.

WARM UP

- 1) Warm up is 30 minutes before performance time.
- 2) There will be an upright piano available. No drum kits or amps will be available.
- 3) Please allow several minutes to move your equipment to the performance stage. We will have guides to assist you.

PERFORMANCE

- 1) Your complete on-stage time is 30 minutes. This includes set-up and tear down.
- 2) There will be a baby grand available for your performance.
- 3) There will be 6 solo microphones plus a m/c and piano microphone available.

CLINIC

- 1) Immediately following your performance, your group will head to the clinic room.
- 2) An upright piano will be available.

AWARDS

- 1) There will be 1st – 3rd place given in each class.
- 2) Each division (excluding combo) will have an outstanding section award (i.e. sax, trumpet, trombone, rhythm).
- 3) Special recognition will be given to an outstanding soloist in each ensemble and combo division.

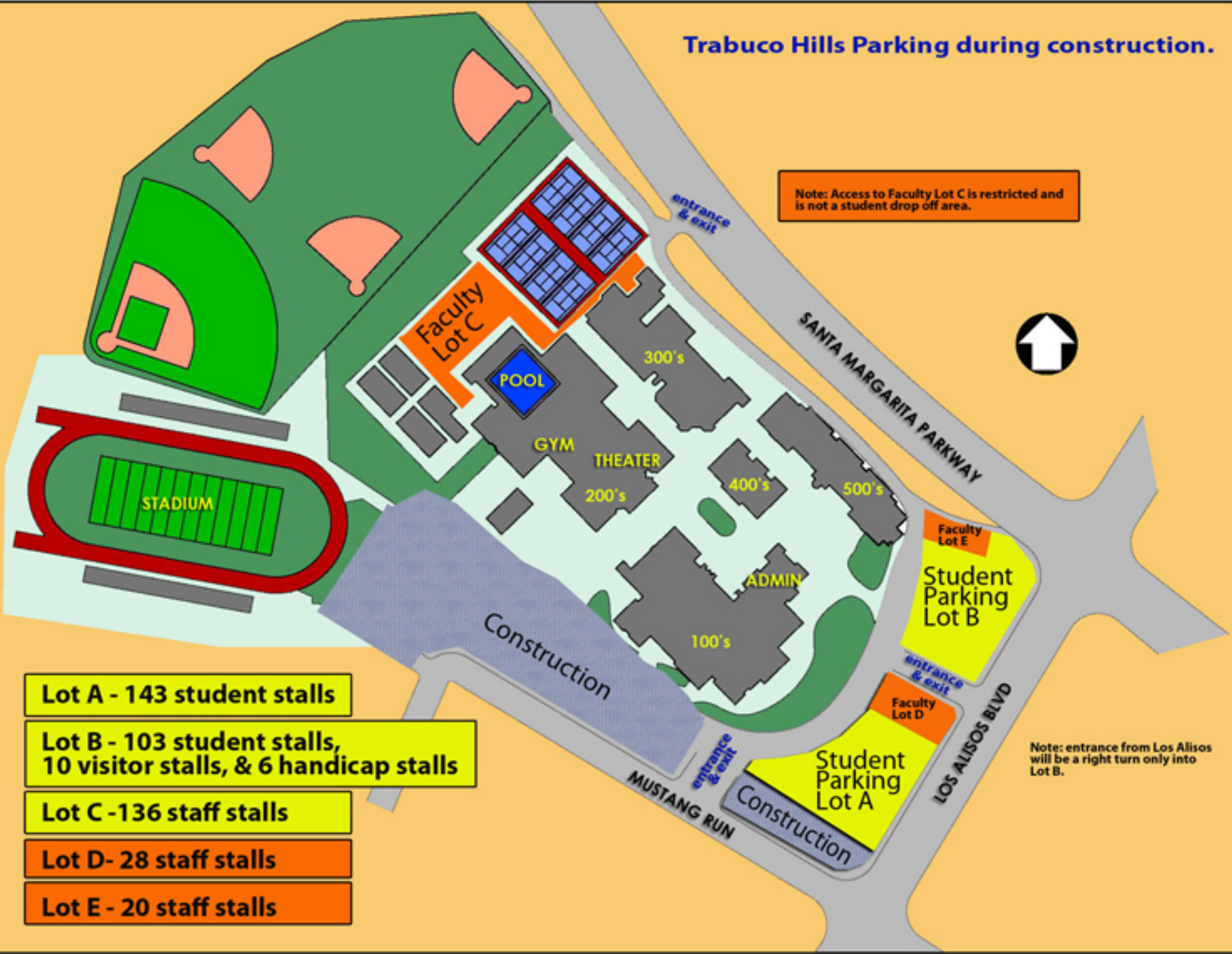

Lot C - 136 staff stalls

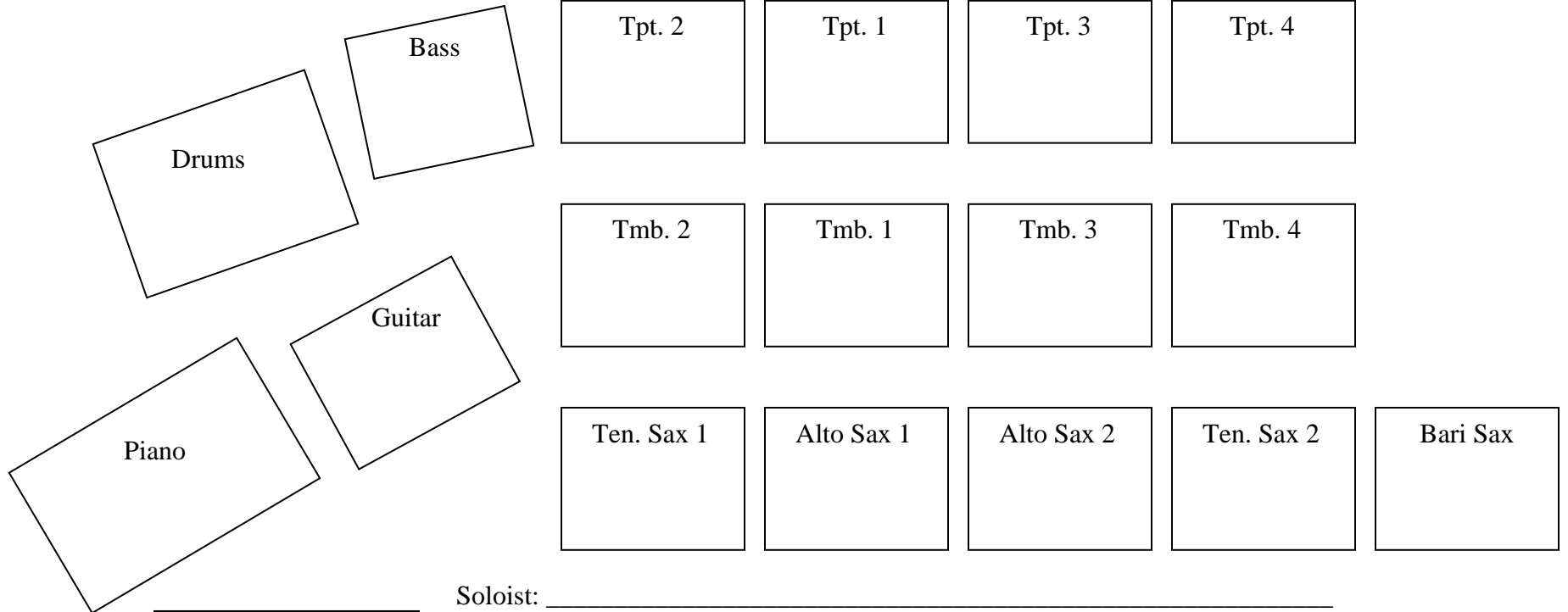
Lot D - 28 staff stalls

From San Diego County

- Take I-5 Freeway North
- Exit Alicia Parkway and turn right
- Turn left on Marguerite Parkway
- Turn left on Mustang Run
- Follow the signs to enter the parking lot

From North Orange County

- Take I-5 Freeway South
- Exit El Toro Road and turn left
- Turn left onto El Toro Road
- Turn right on Santa Margarita Parkway
- Turn right on Los Alisos Boulevard
- Turn right on Mustang Run
- Follow the signs to enter the parking lot

From Los Angeles County

- Take I-405 Freeway South
- Exit El Toro Road and turn left
- Turn left onto El Toro Road
- Turn right on Santa Margarita Parkway
- Turn right on Los Alisos Boulevard
- Turn right on Mustang Run
- Follow the signs to enter the parking lot

From Riverside/San Bernardino Counties

- Take SR-241 *Toll Road* South
- Exit at the 2nd Portola Parkway (*after the Lake Forest exit*) and veer right
- You are now on Santa Margarita Parkway
- Turn right on Los Alisos Boulevard
- Turn right on Mustang Run
- Follow the signs to enter the parking lot
