# CSBC 2025 Division 4A Finals

Welcome to the 2025 CSBC 4A Finals at Huntington Beach High School! Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with the following information.

### 1. LOCATION

### 2. PARKING

*You will likely be heading South on Main Street to HBHS. The campus will be on your right. Please note that buses, trucks, and cars will be directed to different parking areas.*

#### **Bus Parking**

Buses will check-in on Main Street near the marquee in front of the school. **Please have your buses check-in here before attempting to park.** They will then be directed to parking spots at the FCC Church parking lot, Main Street, and on 17th Street. **Please note: now that we are expecting twice as many groups as we were expecting, bus parking will unfortunately be separated from your equipment trucks.** Unfortunately there is no other way for us to park this many groups.

### **Truck Parking**

Truck parking will be in the main school parking lot which can be accessed at Main Street and Utica. Our lot has solar panels so your equipment trucks may be measured for height and directed to park elsewhere.

### **Spectator/Car Parking**

Spectator parking will be at Civic Center across Main Street from the stadium, or on the neighborhood streets.

**DO NOT park at Seacliff Shopping Center AND please alert your parents that the portion of the Civic Center lot nearest the stadium is police station parking only** - vehicles will be cited here! This lot is marked red on the enclosed map.

Handicapped Parking is available near the stadium. Cars will enter off of Main Street and go down the service road that runs between the stadium and bell tower. Spaces will be limited.

### **3. GROUP ARRIVAL**

**Please do not arrive more than two and a half hours prior to performance time.** If you do, we will be able to park your vehicles, but warm-up areas may not be available.

Upon arrival, please go to the Band Check-in, located on Main Street. Here you will meet your student guides, and receive your director's packet. Please check to see if there are any changes in warm-up areas, etc.

### **4. ADMISSIONS**

You already received your director's lanyard and those for your staff. Please wear it at this event. Wristbands will be given out at check-in for performers.

Please note: **Everyone entering the stadium at any point must have a staff pass or wristband. This includes all pit/prop movers!**

### **5. FOOD AND CONCESSIONS**

We will have a wide variety of food options at our concessions stand. Please support our booster group that is hosting this event by choosing to eat with us this Saturday!

Per HBUHSD policy, parking lot picnics are not allowed, which includes no fires or BBQ's of any kind, nor distribution of food. No ice chests nor any outside food will be permitted in the stadium.

## **6. CHANGING AREAS/RESTROOMS**

Restrooms are available at the campus student center as well as in the stadium. **Uniform changing must be done on your buses.**

## **7. WARM-UP AREAS**

Campus maps will be given to you at check-in. Warm-up areas will be assigned to assure every band an ample warm-up period per CSBC. Plan on no lined fields, and lighting may be marginal in some areas after dark. Electricity will not be available.

There is a field adjacent to Worthy Park which can be used for color guard and marching warm-ups.

We ask that you not disturb the performances, and CSBC may issue penalties. As a general rule, if you can see the stadium, they can probably hear you. There is also a concrete stretch through the middle of our campus that projects sound amazingly well directly into the stadium. Avoid any playing in the posted "quiet zones."

Please keep the parking lot and truck parking area free from playing. Props may be pre-staged on the field next to the stadium at the Band Entrance.

## **8. STADIUM ENTRANCE/EXIT**

Gate times are listed on the schedule. Student guides will not be responsible for getting your band there on time. All non-performers must have a staff pass or appropriate wristband to enter here.

Bands will be entering from the rear of side two (stage left). The CSBC announcer will let you know when to enter the field. Bands will exit through the same gate. Bands entering the performance field will have right of way.

## **9. FRONT ENSEMBLES/PIT**

The pit entrance into the stadium is also the band entrance. Upon entering the stadium, pits proceed around to the front of the track. Please keep movement/noise to a minimum during performances.

There will be power at the 50 yard line (front side only). **Bands are responsible for their own back-up in the event of lost power.**

**Gas powered vehicles are NOT ALLOWED on the track at any time.** Those bands bringing gas powered pit vehicles/trailers will be able to drive these to the pre-stage area near the end-zone, where you will need to unload your equipment as stated above.

## **10. STUDENT SEATING**

Students returning to watch other bands will be seated in the back-side stands. Please be efficient with this space so we can fit all of the bands back there. There will be no assigned seating.

## 2025 4-6A State Finals

### Welcome

On behalf of the Colony High School Titan Regiment and CSBC, I would like to extend a warm welcome and personal thank you for participating in our tournament. We plan to host an event of the highest quality for many seasons to come.

### Arrival/Check-In

Busses will park in the south parking lot adjacent to the stadium entering off of **Mill Creek Drive** (please see enclosed map). Directors will receive a packet upon check-in with wristbands for student performers as well as wristbands for chaperones. These wristbands will only give access to the visitor side stands. Performing groups are welcome to watch other bands on the visitor side.

**Bands should NOT arrive earlier than two and a half (2.5) hours before their performance time. DO NOT ARRIVE EARLIER THAN 1pm. If you have logistics issues that create a need to arrive earlier than this time, please contact me directly.**

If chaperones wish to sit on the home side, they will need to purchase a regular show ticket. We will provide staff/chaperone support passes at **1 wristband for every 10 performers.**

Staff members are to use their CSBC badge granting them access to the front stands for viewing and hospitality. These badges were mailed to your school or address you provided to CSBC.

**Badges are NOT to be used by parents or students.**

### Announcements

There is a standard announcer for the event. We will be utilizing the most up to date announcement forms from CSBC. Please confirm your information is correct on the CSBC spreadsheet.

### Warm-Up

Full band warm-up, color guard warm-up, and percussion warm-ups can be done in the quad areas of our campus. Due to proximity to the stadium and respect to the performing units, do not play music in the parking lots. Failure to do so will constitute a penalty (found in the CSBC Contest Rules) after the first warning. Please do not switch warm up spots as it will interfere with show logistics.

## **Band Entry/Exit Point**

All performing groups will enter at the northwest entry gate to the stadium (behind the gym/Side 2). Bands will come down onto the track in the BACK SIDE 2 end zone area to leave room for the parting band to EXIT FRONT SIDE 2 (see map). Pits will use the track in similar fashion.

Be sure to have your group positioned to enter the field one full performance slot ahead of your own. Late arrival to the gate will cause a traffic jam of the departing band and may cause a timing penalty of your own group to deploy on the field in sufficient time. Please plan accordingly.

## **Percussion Equipment/Props**

Please make sure you have adequate staff and means to assist the moving of your percussion equipment and props to and from the performance area. Absolutely no trucks or vehicles of significant weight will be allowed on the track. We ask that all pit percussion sections arrive at least ONE band prior to your groups' scheduled performance time. Pits will enter AND exit at the same entrance as the band on the northwest entry of the stadium.

## **Seating in Stands**

Upon completion of your band's performance, please have your group sit on the visitor side to watch field shows. Students will have full access to concessions and vendors. Please recommend your students bring cash to buy dinner at concessions as not all vendors will accept credit/debit.

LOCAL RULE CONCERNING FOOD SERVICE/BARBECUES: ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD SERVICES OR BARBECUES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE PARKING LOT. THERE ARE NO OUTSIDE FOOD/DRINK OR COOLERS ALLOWED INTO THE CAMPUS, STADIUM, OR PARKING LOTS.

Performing units are allowed to bring water for their performances.

## **Admission/Concession Stand**

Admission to this event is \$20, with kids 5 and under being free. A variety of food and beverages will be on sale to your students, chaperones, and band parents. This is a fundraiser event and we encourage all participants to support the Colony Titan Regiment by purchasing food at the concession stands in the stadium.

## **Vendors**

Colony is proud to host a number of outside vendors in addition to our regular concessions. These vendors will include a variety of different products for you to choose from!

## **Hospitality**

To show our gratitude for your participation in our event, we have a hospitality area prepared for all directors and staff. Staff and directors must have a badge to enter. Please do not send parents/chaperones/bus drivers to this area. Our hospitality area is sponsored by the Colony Band Boosters. Enjoy!

## **Awards Ceremony**

The awards ceremony will begin after the last performing group (approximately 30 minutes). Directors with concerns should report to our Head Judge, Michael J. Spillman. CSBC is committed to providing quality adjudication and welcomes your comments and suggestions (<https://goo.gl/forms/A5gZ1au3S8ZLe8Sv2>). Please have your ENTIRE BAND line-up in order of performance on the track at the southeast (visitor side near street) side of the stadium PRIOR to the last performance.

## **Spectator Parking**

Spectator parking is available in any of the open parking lots not being utilized by the tournament staff for band parking. Lots are located at the front of the campus off of Riverside Drive, or on the east side of the campus off Mill Creek Drive. **Cars parked in the band zone will be towed at the owner's expense.**

## Colony High School

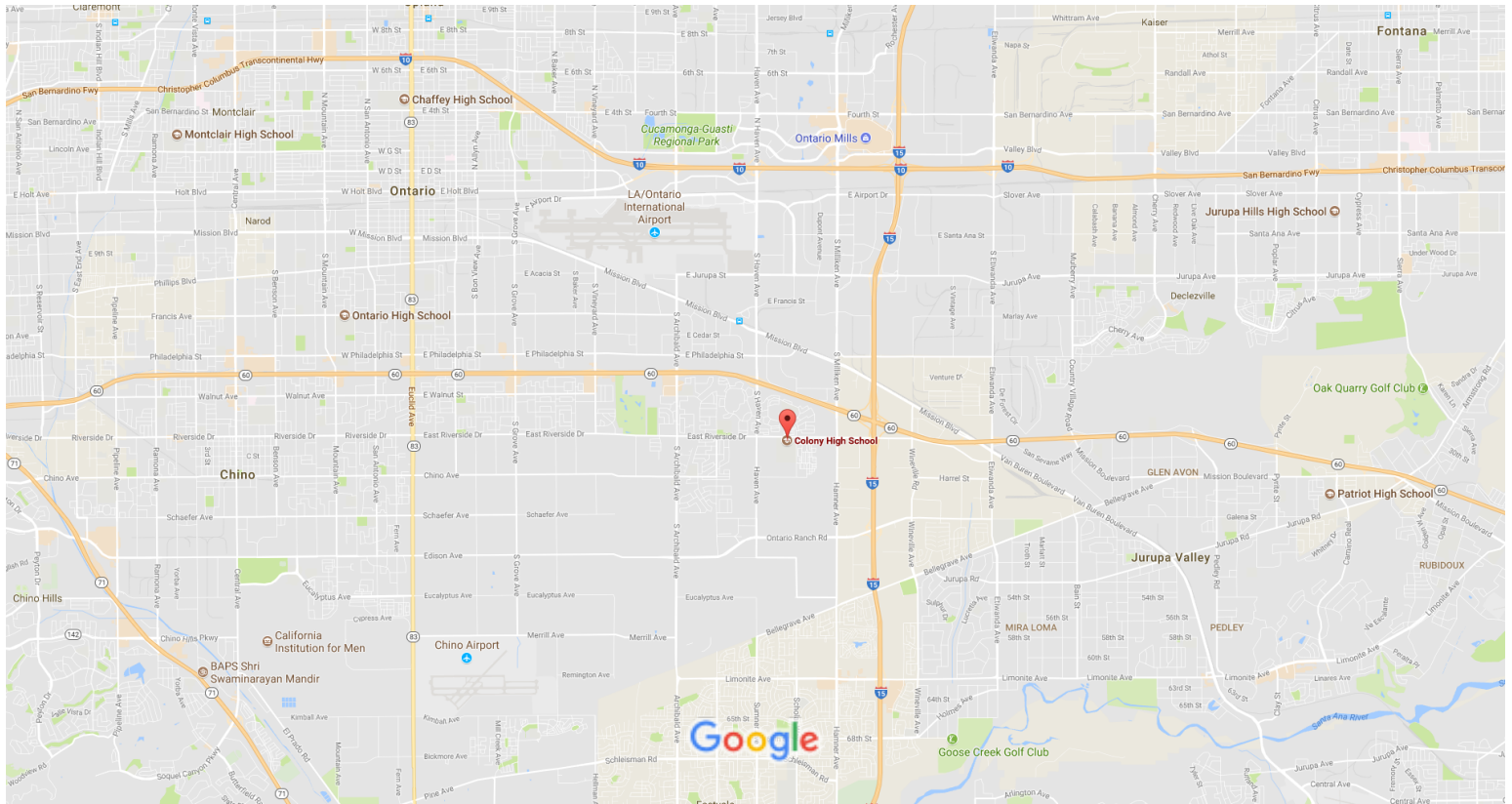
We are located near the intersection of the 15 and Highway 60. We are just south of the 10.

From the south, take either the 241 or the 5 north. Head east on the 91 or 60 and then head towards the intersection of the 60 and 15.

From the west, take the 10 east and use either the 15 or 71 to make your way to COHS off the 60.

From the north, head south on the 5 and take the 10 east before heading south on the 15 towards COHS.

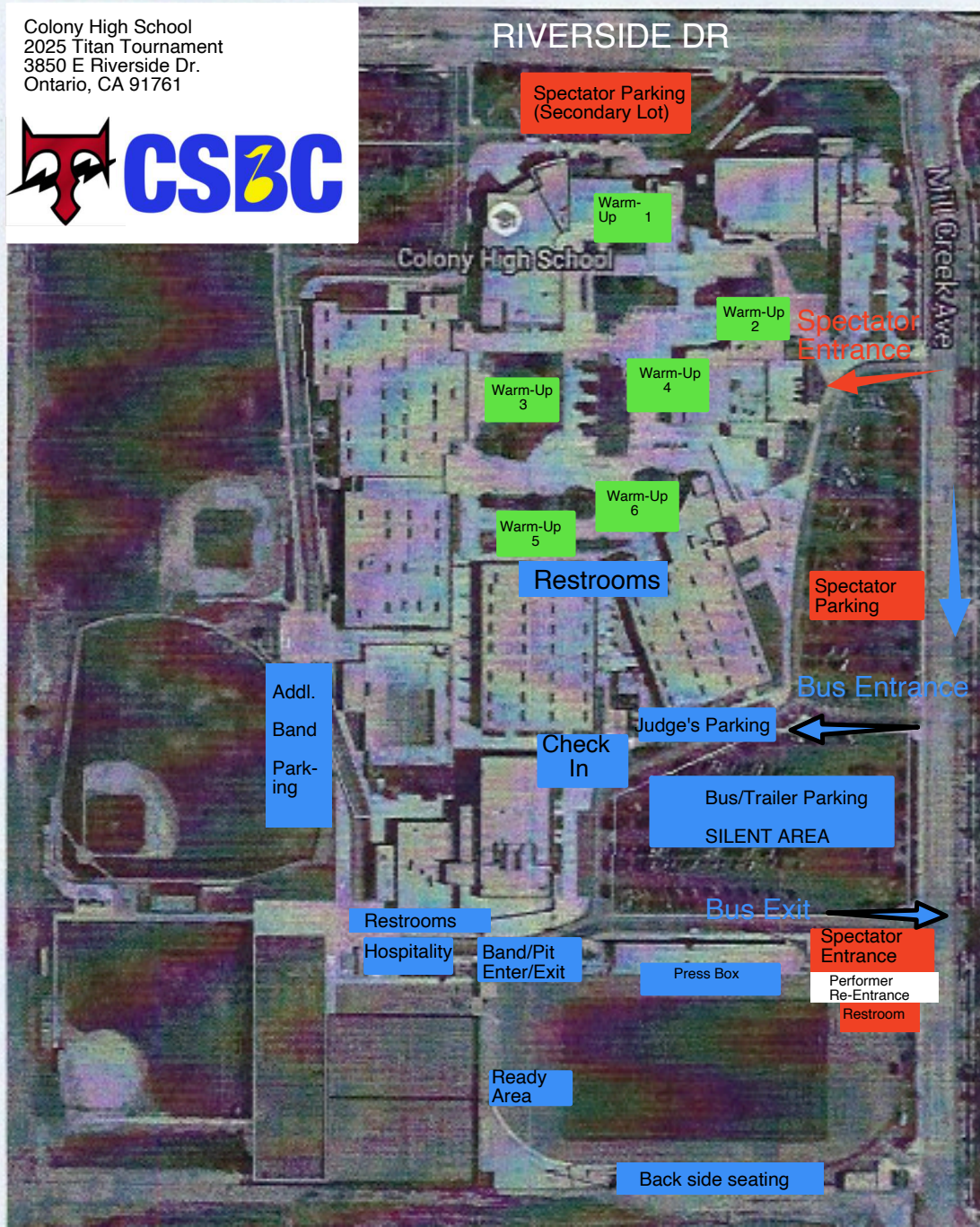
From the east, head west on the 10 or 60 and make your way to COHS off the 60.

After the last band's performance, bands line up (in full uniform) in performance order, and wait outside the band entrance. Once signaled, the host drumline will start playing and bands will begin to enter the field area. The announcer will announce the name of each band as they are coming down the field. Each band will come down and stop at the front side numbers. Once all bands are lined up the announcer will ask Student Leaders to come "Front (to the home sideline) and Center".
