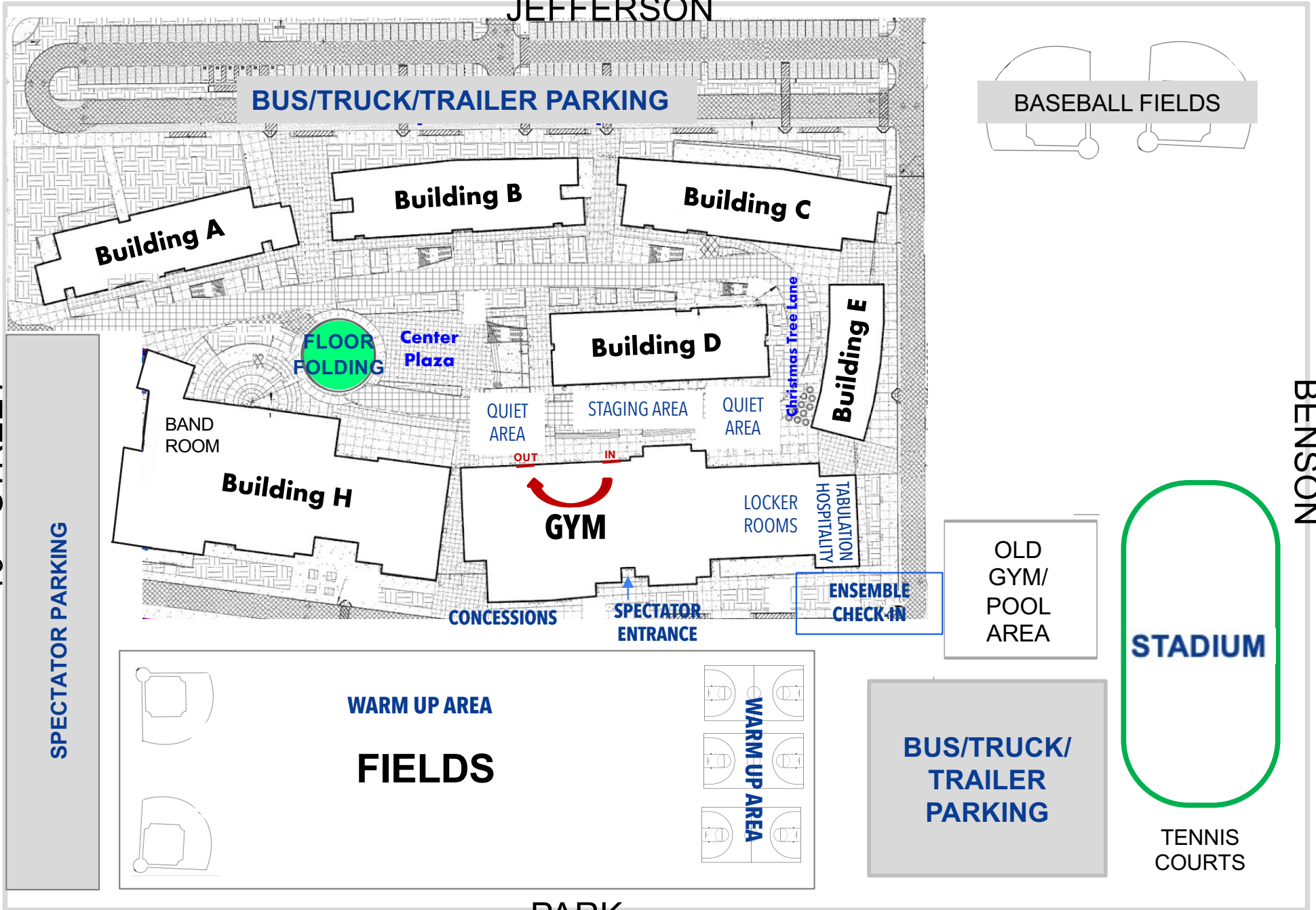

(2 double doors)



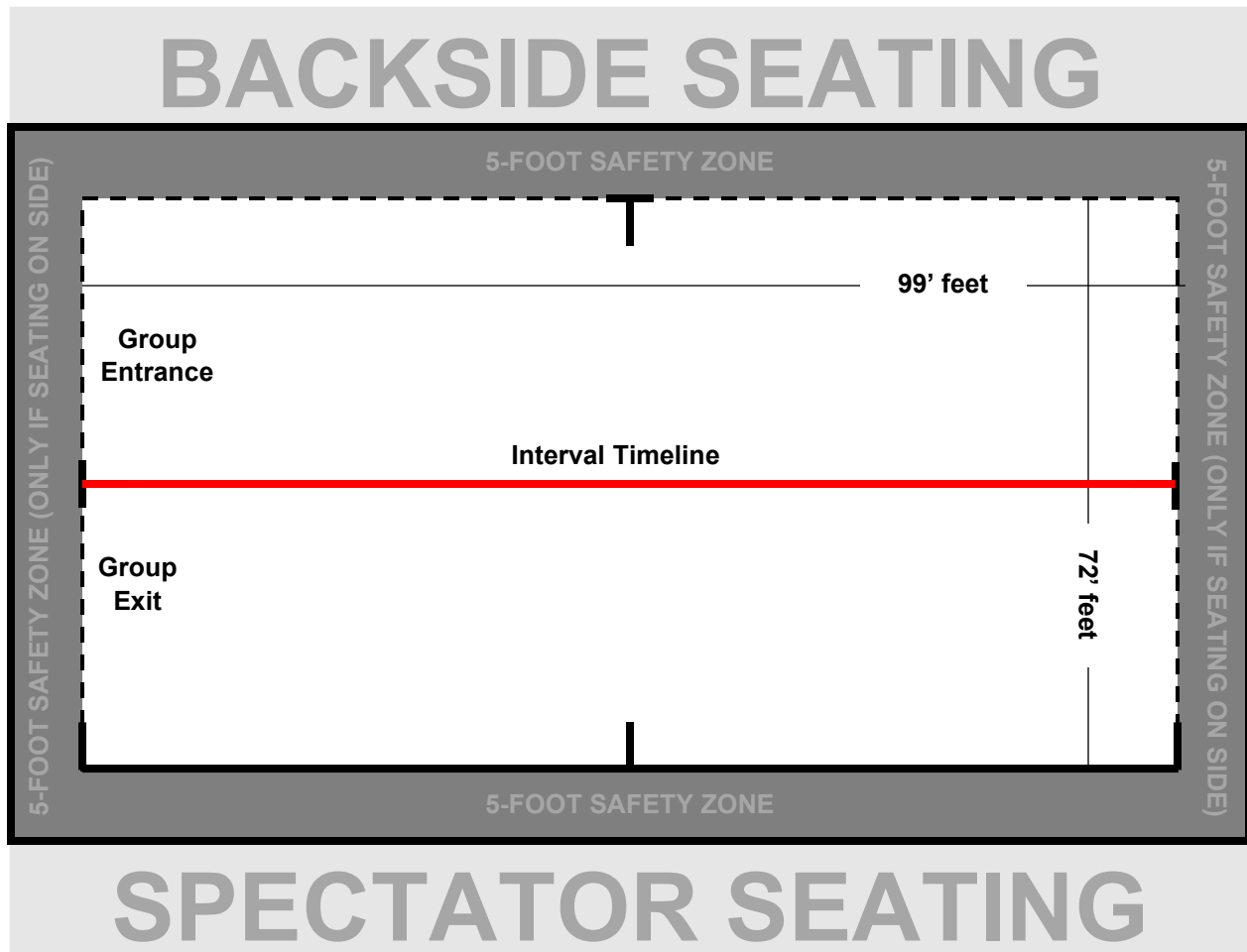
Exit Doors

Ontario Regional Competition Area Chino High School | Ontario, CA

All WGI contest sites must have a minimum of seventy feet by one hundred feet (70' x 100') to accommodate a "safety zone" of five (5) feet from any spectator seating. This will ensure the minimum sixty-foot by ninety-foot (60' x 90') competition area within the minimum seventy feet by one hundred feet (70' x 100') of the contest site. If no spectators are seated on the left and right sides, then the safety zone will be eliminated on the left and right sides of the competition area and extend to the walls.

The competition area at this event measures 72' x 99'. All performing groups must be prepared to perform within that area. Floors (tarps) may not extend into the safety zones per rules found in the WGI Adjudication Manual and Rulebook.





GROUP INFO/SPIEL SHEET: Please be sure to fill out your group's show information for WGI in CompetitionSuite. If you do not fill out this information prior to the regional then only your group name, city, and state will be announced.

- Log into CompetitionSuite and select your WGI group. You will find the Spiel Sheet under Organization Data. Make sure to complete all information. CompetitionSuite information completed for a local circuit is not shared with WGI unless you merge your accounts. Please contact the WGI Office if you have any questions (office@wgi.org / 937.247.5919 x 301).

GROUP CHECK-IN: Be prepared to declare the number of performers. Penalties will be assigned for false declarations (Rule 8.2). Performers and ten (10) staff will be admitted at no charge. Groups must check in at least one hour prior to performance time regardless of indoor warm-up use.

DRESSING FACILITIES: These may be available on-site. WGI and the event partners are not responsible for lost items.

FOOTWEAR AND EQUIPMENT PROTECTION: Rule 4.1

TABULATING AND JUDGING AREA: These areas are off-limits to everyone except authorized personnel.

ELECTRICAL POWER: Power will be provided at front and back centerline at the contest.

EQUIPMENT/PROPS: All equipment and props must be removed from the building **immediately following** your performance.

VIDEOS: No video cameras will be allowed in any contest venue and no authorized space will be provided for groups to record their performance. Any liability associated with unauthorized recordings will rest with the individual or organization making the recording. WGI does not condone, nor accept any liability for, any unauthorized recording during the event.

FINALS SCHEDULES: All finals schedules are available on WGI.org. These are updated throughout the day as individual class prelims are completed.

AWARDS: Captains only. If your group is not attending retreat, please designate one individual (parent, staffer, or designated representative) to stay and retrieve your award at the conclusion of retreat. Please inform the Contest Administrator on-site if your group will not be attending retreat.

CRITIQUE: When time allows, critique is offered at WGI Percussion and Winds events. Please view the schedule for the critique start time. All interested groups should report at the start of critique to be called in performance order.

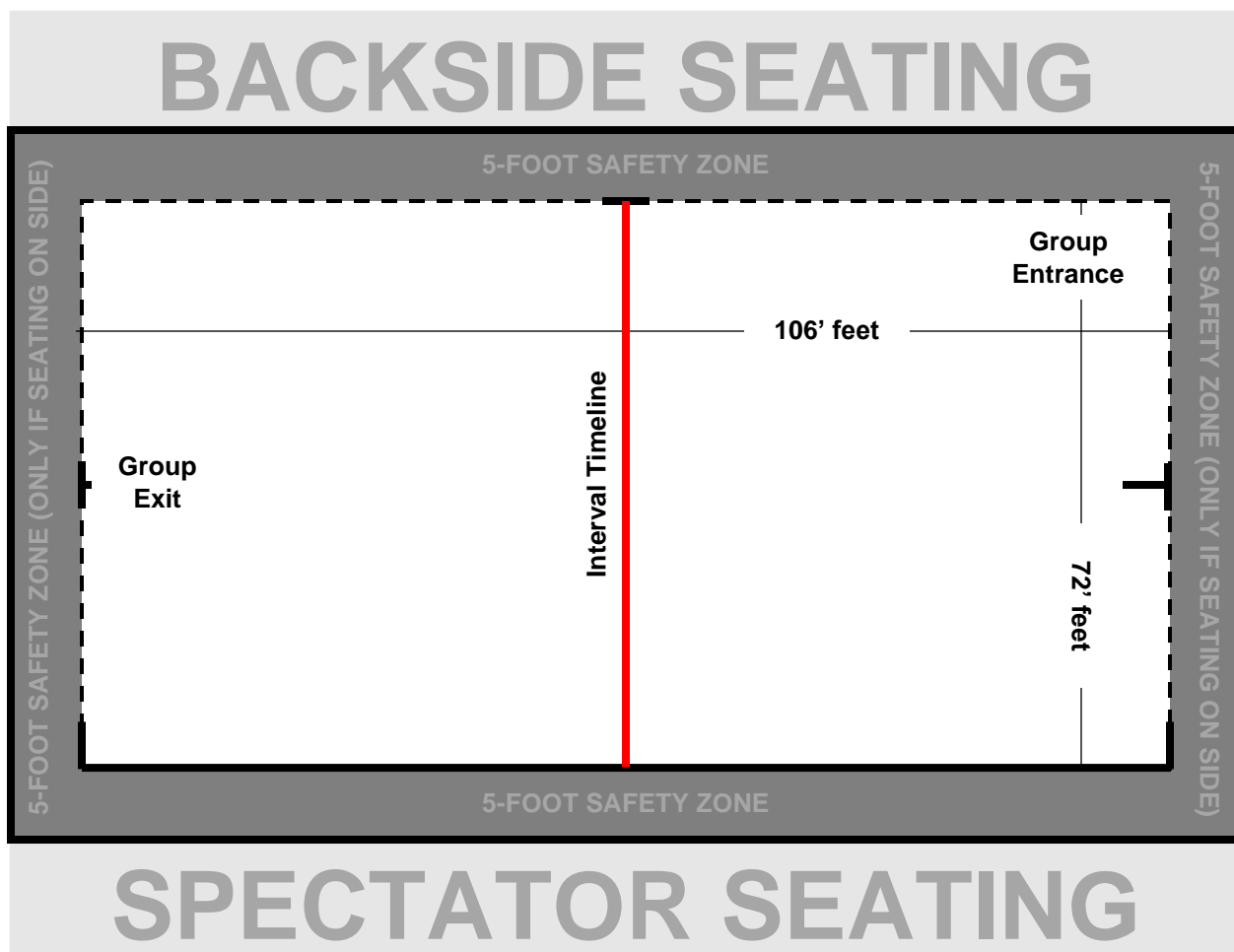
